WHAT'S NEW? REFWORKS!

Brand-new to the Evans Library is RefWorks, citation management software that helps researchers organize their citations and create bibliographies. RefWorks can be found on the LINK's list of Express Links and from within many of its databases.

RefWorks provides the following features:

- the creation of an individualized database of citations
- the formatting of citations and footnotes
- the ability to either 1) input citations manually or 2) export citations directly from a number of the research databases at Evans Library.

To access RefWorks, Library users must:

- sign up for an individual account (click on Register - first-time use only)
- enter required information including a login name and password

Tutorials and other helps are available.
